After you have all your information about each topic start creating word processing documents for each. Use your own words. You may quote specific web sites and information but you may not simply copy and paste into a word processing document. That is referred to as PLAGIARISM. You may want to take each image you find, that supports your writing, and open it into Photoshop and edit it to get it to the size, shape and colors you are trying to achieve. Note that you can control all the above aspects through Power Point as well. Using Power Point you will create your presentation. Use the interface to organize your slides and set up a presentation that is chronologically based and incorporates all your images and information about all 20 topics. At a very minimum you should have 21 slides, 1 introduction or title slide and 20 supporting slides. Here are your topics.

2. What was the underground railroad?
3. Who was W.E.B. Du Bois?
4. An Image of Malcolm X
5. A copy of or quotes from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s speech.
6. Why was the 1968 Democratic National Convention in Chicago significant to black history?
7. An Image of Angela Davis.
8. An image of Bobby Seale and Huey P. Newton
9. The cover of the book "I know why the caged bird sings".
10. An image from the march on Washington for jobs and freedom.
11. An image of the Million Man March.
12. An image of Harriet Tubman.
13. An image of an ad for "Roots".
14. A movie Poster from the film "In the heat of the night".
15. An illustration or image of a slave ship.
16. A map of Africa.
17. An image of Nelson Mandela .
18. A piece of art work created by Faith Ringold.
19. Who were the Tuskegee Airmen?
20. An image of Jackie Robinson.
