

PRE-LAW PROGRAM

As the Law School Admission Council's Campus Liaison and Coordinating Pre-Law Advisor and a Southern Association of Pre-Law Advisors member, I am chiefly responsible for providing MSU students with the Law School Application Test (LSAT) materials and advising them on taking the LSAT and applying to law school.

Pre-Law Publications

To assist MSU pre-law students, I have authored two publications which are available from the Department of Geography, Government, and History, 350 Rader Hall and on the GGH web site.

Societas Pro Legibus

Societas Pro Legibus (SPL), created in 1995, is MSU's pre-law society. Students interested in joining may obtain application forms at the MSU pre-law web program site, or from *Pre-Law at MSU* booklet. As the faculty advisor, I assist its officers and members in promoting and accomplishing the following activities.

Fall Semester

Societas Pro Legibus hosts a colloquium of Kentucky's law school deans of admissions, sponsors two pre-law group activities, a freshmen and sophomores recruiting session and a law school admission process workshop, and holds mock LSATs to prepare students for the October and December exams.

Spring Semester

Societas Pro Legibus bestows the Pre-Law Scholar Award, sponsors a workshop on studying for the LSAT, and holds a mock LSAT to prepare students for the June exam.

Pre-Law Scholar Award Recipients

Since 1995, Societas Pro Legibus has bestowed its annual Pre-Law Scholar Award on the student with the highest LSAT score and GPA who has been admitted to law school. The award includes certificate and a copy of a leading legal treatise.
